

## **Making A Poster : Georgia Government Hanger Project**

**S8CG2 The student will analyze the role of the legislative branch in Georgia state government.**

a. Explain the qualifications, term, election, and duties of members of the General Assembly.

**SS8CG3 The student will analyze the role of the executive branch in Georgia state government.**

a. Explain the qualifications, term, election, and duties of the governor and lieutenant governor.

**SS8CG4 The student will analyze the role of the judicial branch in Georgia state government.**

a. Explain the structure of the court system in Georgia including trial and appellate procedures and how judges are selected.

Georgia Government is set up similarly to Federal Government, in that it contains 3 separate branches that can each “check” one another. The 3 branches are the Executive, the Legislative, and the Judicial branches. There is some different vocabulary used to differentiate between state government and federal government. Please make sure to use all proper STATE government terms, and do not get confused with federal terms.

**Directions:** You will need to create a Hanging Mobile for this project. The best and most efficient way to create this mobile is to use a clothes hanger that has an attached bottom. You will need to separate the 3 Branches of state government on the mobile, by attaching string/yarn/ribbon to each corner and one in the center of the bottom of the hanger. Attach an index card with the designated branches written on it, for each of the branches. Then attach another piece of string/yarn/ribbon to the bottom of the index card, so that you can attach another index card. This second level of index cards should read Requirements for the \_\_\_\_\_ (fill in proper vocabulary term for each branch). Finally, add another piece of string/yarn/ribbon to the bottom of each of those index cards and attach your final row (3<sup>rd</sup>) of index cards that show the Duties and Responsibilities of each of the positions.
